

ORDERING CUTTINGS

- Orders can only be accepted on RVIC forms. These must be signed and dated.
- Please record the variety, clone and the number of cuttings (multiples of 100) in the grade required. Please refer to cutting specifications when choosing the grade.
- Indicate any optional services you require to the cuttings. ie Cold storage, Hot Water Treatment. These are at an additional cost.
- Alterations to original order will only be accepted in writing.
- A deposit may be requested on material ordered.
- Orders received after 31st August will incur fungicide and cold storage charges.
- Full payment is required prior to dispatch.

RVIC Terms and Conditions of supply are clearly stated on the reverse of the order forms.

Please note a packaging and storage fee of \$45 applies to all orders less than 1000.

- ✓ Interstate Plant Health Certificate.
Charge \$20.00 in addition to the DPI charge for each certificate.(approx.\$130)
- ✓ Cold Store
Charge \$30.00 plus \$11.00 per 100 cuttings, and includes fungicide treatment and extends the cold storage time to 30th November
- ✓ Hot Water Treatment
Base Rate of \$110 Plus \$30 per 1000
- ✓ Freight and Postage
Charged at cost plus \$20 handling per dispatch

CUTTING SOURCE

To establish our 80ha of source vineyards at Monash, RVIC have obtained vines from local trials, recognised collections throughout Australia and overseas imports. These source vineyards are specially grown to promote healthy, high quality cuttings.

Great care is taken by RVIC to ensure a consistently high quality product is supplied. The cutting specification and bud numbers in the tables below are provided as a guide, not a guarantee.

CUTTING SPECIFICATIONS - VINIFERA

Length is measured from the base cut to the top of the cutting without consideration for the position of the top bud.

Diameter is measured approx 5cm below the top of the cutting.

Grafting grade: The base cut is made up to 5cm below the base bud.
Suited to benchgrafting and top working

Planting grade: The base cut is made within 1cm of the base bud.
Suited to planting in field nursery

Thin grade: The base cut is made up to 5cm below the base bud
Suited to chipbudding nursery vines, benchgrafting onto thin rootstock

CUTTING SPECIFICATIONS - ROOTSTOCK

Length is measured from the base cut to the top of the cutting without consideration for the position of the top bud.

Diameter is measured approx 5cm below the top of the cutting.

Grafting grade: The base cut is made up to 5cm below the base bud.
Suited to benchgrafting. Not suited to field planting.

Thin grade: The base cut is made up to 5cm below the base bud
Suited to benchgrafting with thin vinifera
